EXAMPLE

Fishing guide reports are to be submitted online at the following address <https://app.fw.ky.gov/commReport> by the 15th day of every month for the previous month's guiding activities, if "I plan to be a fishing guide" or "Both hunting and fishing guide" is indicated on commercial guide license application. Completion of this form and submittal to the Kentucky Department of Fish & Wildlife Resources is required each month, even if no guiding occurred the previous month. This paper log is provided to assist with tracking trips throughout the month, with information to be entered online at <https://app.fw.ky.gov/commReport>.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING FORM

<b>Sign in to Online Portal to Submit Report</b>	Sign in to online portal <a href="https://app.fw.ky.gov/commReport">https://app.fw.ky.gov/commReport</a> . Paper reports will not be accepted. This log is only to assist with tracking activities throughout the month.
<b>Did Not Fish</b>	If no guided trips occurred in previous month, you must still sign in to the online portal and select did not fish for each month.
<b>Waterbody</b>	Enter the waterbody you guided on. Separate paper logs will be needed for tracking if trips are taken on multiple waterbodies in a month.
<b>Date Fished</b>	Enter the date for which the guided trip occurred. If more than one guided trip occurs per day, record each trip separately using the same date. Only trips in Kentucky waters are required. For overnight trips, use the the start date.
<b>Species of Fish Targeted</b>	Select the primary species targeted. If multiple species were targeted, choose the one the majority of time was spent on.
<b>Number of Anglers</b>	Enter the total number of anglers on the trip, including the guide if they fish.
<b>Hours Fished</b>	Enter the number of hours fished, rounded to the nearest hour.
<b>Species and Number of Fish Caught</b>	Write in species caught in the column heading, and enter number of fish caught and released for each trip in rows. If no fish were caught, enter 0 for that trip date.
<b>Not Legal Released</b>	Enter the number of not legal fish (below minimum size limit, within protected slot size limit, or when no daily harvest is allowed) that were caught and released. If species does not have a minimum size limit or protected slot limit enter 0.
<b>Legal Released</b>	Provide the count of legal-size fish (above minimum size limit, not within protected slot size limit, or where no minimum size limit exist) that were caught and released.
<b>Kept</b>	Record the number of fish kept. For bowfishing, count all fish shot as kept.
