

**BLUE GRASS ARMY DEPOT
SPRING TURKEY HUNT APPLICATION
2024**

Mailed applications must be postmarked no later than February 29, 2024. There is no fee to apply.

There will be 40 youth hunters selected for April 20. Those 40 must be accompanied by an adult. Only the youth will be allowed to harvest a turkey. There will be 40 hunters selected for May 4. Those 40 may bring one guest that must accompany them at all times. This allows a maximum of 80 hunters total. If more applications are received than slots, the lottery drawing will take place at Blue Grass Army Depot. Each hunter may harvest one bearded turkey. Turkey will be limited to number 4 or smaller size bird shot. Turkey taken at BGAD ARE bonus tags.

All hunters (except youth) will be required to obtain an AIE badge from the BGAD badging office prior to the hunt date. The badging office is open 6:00 – 4:00 on M – F. The office number is 859-779-6090. ANY prior convictions will disqualify you from hunting.
