^{*}Please base estimates of bin fullness on tightly packed line (less than ¼, ¼, ¼, ¾, full).

Instructions:

- 1. Please empty each collection bin at least once a month or more often if necessary.
- 2. Remove any hooks, weights, leaders, lures or other fishing paraphernalia from the monofilament.
- 3. Properly dispose of any braided or fluorocarbon line or monofilament encrusted with vegetation or bait that cannot be reasonably cleaned.
- 4. Properly dispose of all trash.
- 5. Record the amount of line recovered from the outdoor collection bin with each visit on the FLRRP data sheet. Completed forms can be dropped off, mailed, faxed, or emailed.
- 6. Deposit all cleaned and cleared monofilament in a Berkley indoor recycling station.

Suggested items for line collection:

- Rubber/latex gloves
- Grocery store bags (to collect line)
- Small scissors or nail clippers (to remove hooks, etc.)
- Large pliers or wrench (in case plug is too tight)
- Short stick with hook on the end (to reach inside container to retrieve line)
- Spray bottle with 10% bleach solution (for occasional rinsing of inside of container)

^{*}One piece of trash = one soda can or one cigarette pack.

^{*}If there is a problem with the bin, please briefly note the nature of the problem on the back of this form for KDFWR recordkeeping and inform KDFWR of issue that needs to be resolved.
