Small game and furbearer hunting and trapping on public areas

This administrative regulation establishes exceptions to statewide hunting and trapping regulations for small game and furbearers on public areas.

Significant Changes

This amendment establishes smaller size restrictions on dry land body-gripping traps used on public lands, and establishes a standard means of registration for persons trapping on department-owned or operated Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) and Otter Creek Outdoor Recreation Area. This amendment also allows a person to hunt coyotes after daylight hours on Robinson Forest WMA, and restricts coyote hunting on Redbird WMA to daylight hours only.
