Foothold trap	Submersion for wildlife trapped in water sets	Bury the carcass and all parts in the earth: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • in a location not covered with overflow or ponds • not less than 100 feet from a watercourse, sinkhole, well, spring, public highway, residence, or stable • at least 1 foot deep and covered with 1 foot of earth
Box trap	Cervical dislocation or thoracic compression for small mammals and birds, except that bats and federally protected birds shall not be dispatched.	
Snare	Mechanical stunning followed by acceptable euthanasia method	
Wire cage trap	Inhalants, including halothane, isoflurane, carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide	
Deadfall trap	Commercially available agents for striped skunks	
	Commercially available rodenticides for rodents	Licensed rendering establishment
