**2022-23 Official Criteria for Hosting a KyNASP® State Qualifying  
NASP®/IBO 3D Challenge Tournament**

A 2022-2023 KyNASP® State Qualifying NASP®/IBO 3D Challenge Tournament Must.....

- Be held between Friday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 and Saturday, February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023.  
(all scores MUST be uploaded by 9pm ET on Saturday, Feb 25<sup>th</sup> to be considered)
- Follow the official 2023 KyNASP®/IBO 3D Challenge tournament rules posted at [www.fw.ky.gov/nasp](http://www.fw.ky.gov/nasp) .
- Post your tournament with “**NASP®/IBO 3D Challenge**” as part of the tournament name.
- Open Flight Selection at least 3 weeks prior to the tournament. (to allow everyone an opportunity to see the listing & sign up)
- Have a minimum capacity of 100 archers. Have safe entry and exit of audience while shooting is taking place.
- Allow a period of time (minimum of one day) for Kentucky schools to register before archers/teams from other states are allowed to register. A single host team may select flight positions for up to 24 of their archers prior to the opening of flight selection.
- **A tournament with the minimum of 100 registered archers may not be canceled unless the school district has canceled all activities due to inclement weather or other emergency. (A host may not cancel due to low number participation).**
- Have a standard NASP®/IBO 3D range setup (**including the placement of arrow curtain in an angle formation behind animals**)
  - Lanes must be 5 feet wide with lanes and centers clearly marked on the shooting lines.
  - 2 quivers per target are required
  - Target line, shooting lines and waiting lines must be present and properly spaced. (a waiting area space must be present in front of audience seating)
- Have a minimum of one range official per 6 targets (6 targets makes a single 3D range)
  - Range officials must be adults and non-students. (Certified BAI range officials are preferred. You must have one BAI certified range official on the range at all times)
  - The Announcer can count as one of the officials if they are also working at the targets while students are scoring.
  - All range workers and announcers must be familiar with the NASP®/IBO 3D Challenge Rules and Regulations document.
- Make sure each target has 2 archers from different schools when possible.
  - If both archers at a target are from the same school, a range official must score the target.
  - If only one archer is at a target, the range official must score the target.
  - Range officials should never be officiating a target where they are affiliated with the school of one or both archers.
  - All archers must shoot on the same range(s). Schools cannot offer flights at “different” times or locations and restrict those flights to certain groups. For example.... They cannot allow XYZ elementary school to shoot in their own gym and use those scores or allow their own host school to shoot at a time not listed as a flight.
  - Range officials must listen and watch students scoring to verify they are scoring with the approved scoring protocol.
  - The intent is to make maintain the integrity of our tournaments and ensure they meet the same standards as the state tournament.
- Use the <http://nasptournaments.org/> and NASP\_Pro.accdb software or use the NASP Portal APP to score with adult scorers or adults entering scores instead of using a scanner. Archers will still score with cards.
- Use official scorecards and scanner. (unless using the scoring APP)
- Post the results at <http://nasptournaments.org/>
- Charge no more than \$10 per archer. Pay \$2 per archer (who shoots) to NASP®. A printable invoice will be available online after scores are uploaded. (This includes the use of the software and phone support from NASP® technology and Kentucky regional coordinators). **An additional \$2 per archer will be billed from KyNASP® if 3D targets are borrowed from KyNASP®. Contact [lisa.frye@ky.gov](mailto:lisa.frye@ky.gov) if you need to borrow animals.**

**(NASP®/IBO 3D Challenge state qualifier team scores will ranked and posted on [nasptournaments.org](http://nasptournaments.org) under “rankings”. Teams will advance to the State Tournament based on these rankings. The top 30 teams from each division is guaranteed advancement.)**



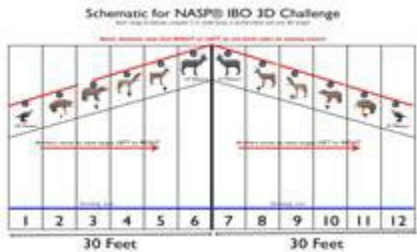

### Qualifying Tournament Checklist:

- Minimum capacity of 100 archers?
- Safe entry and exit of spectators while shooting is taking place?
- Standard 3D range setup **(including the placement of arrow curtain in an angle formation behind animals)**



- 5 foot lanes?
- 2 quivers per target?
- target/shooting/waiting lines present and properly spaces (waiting area space present in front of spectator seating)?
- Range Officials
  - Minimum of 1 per 6 targets at all times on the range?
  - Are they adults and non-students? (scoring room officials must be adults and non-students also)
  - Lane Official video and scoring protocol video viewed.
  - Must be familiar with KyNASP® and KyNASP®/IBO 3D Challenge rules and regulations document. Certified BAI officials are preferred. At least one BAI working on the range at all times.
  - Must work the range by moving to the targets at scoring (watching/listening archers score) and back behind archers during shooting (trying not to be in spectators way of watching their archer(s)).
  - Must score individual archers – Must score target if the two archers are from the same school.
- Scoring
  - Adult workers only in score room or scoring area. Individual over registration and scoring must be BAI certified.
  - (Individuals not able to show credentials on the NASP Portal APP of association for tournament registration purposes **MAY NOT** register/add student archers).
  - Use official scorecards and scanner. Post results. (unless using the scoring APP)
- Cost
  - No more than \$10 per archer. (\$2 per archer will be invoiced from NASP for use of software and phone support from NASP® technology and KyNASP® regional coordinators) An additional \$2 per archer will be billed from KyNASP® if 3D targets are borrowed from KyNASP®.

**I agree that our tournament will meet state qualifying tournament requirements and expectations. I understand that failure to meet state qualifying tournament requirements and expectations will result in the inability of our school and all BAI associated with our school from hosting future state qualifying tournaments for up to one year.**
