Do I qualify for KyNASP® State:

KyNASP® registration protocols for the 2026 KyNASP® State Bullseye and 3D Tournaments:

• Advancement to the KyNASP® State Tournament is based on the best team and individual score from KyNASP® State Qualifying Bullseye and 3D Tournaments.

Bullseye:

- High Schools with a score of 3100 or more may pre-register
- Middle Schools with a score of 3000 or more may pre-register
- Elementary Schools with a score of 2500 or more may pre-register
- Individuals: High 285+, Middle 275+, Elementary 265+

3D:

- High Schools with a score of 1475 or more may pre-register
- Middle Schools with a score of 1425 or more may pre-register
- Elementary Schools with a score of 1225 or more may pre-register
- Individuals: High 285+, Middle 275+, Elementary 265+

Pre-Registration: January 1st, 2026 @ 8AM EST– February 15th, 2026 @ 8AM EST

****** Registration for all tiers on both bullseye and 3D state tournament closes Thursday, February 19th, 2026 at 8am EST ******

Bullseye:

- KyNASP Bullseye state registration will use a new Auto Flight Selection/Registration process on Sunday, February 15th, 2026 and Monday, February 16th, 2026. Drop by date is Tuesday, February 17th at 8am ET.
- Only schools that select flight preferences during pre-registration will receive flight selections during the auto-flight selection if their flight preferences are available.
- It is critical that a school selects ALL flight times that they are willing to accept during pre-registration.
- Coaches will be notified of their bullseye auto flight selection by email and then registration will open for them by the schedule below. This will allow them to make changes immediately instead of waiting for all flight selections to be made.

- **KyNASP State Bullseye Tournament auto-flight selection and registration schedule:** All pre-registered teams will be involved in an auto-flight selection process directly followed by a registration opening for changes. The auto flight selection process for each tier (group of ranked teams/individuals), will occur in two-hour increments. Once registration opens for a tier, changes can be made. The tier will stay open for changes until the end of registration. **Rankings can be found at <https://www.nasptournaments.org> under the “Rankings” tab. Select “State Qualifying” tournaments and then select the state of KY.**
 - Tier 1: Teams that ranked in the top 10 in their division – 1pm ET on Sun, February 15th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 1pm and the top 10 ranked teams per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 1pm ET when registration opens for this tier of teams.
 - Tier 2: Teams that ranked in the top 30 in their division – 3 pm ET on Sun, February 15th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 3pm and the top 11 to 30 ranked teams per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 3pm ET when registration opens up for this tier of teams.
 - Tier 3: Teams that ranked in the top 50 in their division – 5 pm ET on Sun, February 15th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 5pm and the top 31 to 50 ranked teams per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 5pm ET when registration opens up for this tier of teams.
 - Tier 4: Teams that ranked in the top 75 in their division – 7 pm ET on Sun, February 15th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 7pm and the top 51 to 75 ranked teams per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 7pm ET when registration opens up for this tier of teams.
 - Tier 5: Teams that ranked in the top 100 in their division – 9 am ET on Mon, February 16th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 9am and the top 76 to 100 ranked teams per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 9am ET when registration opens up for this tier of teams.
 - Tier 6: Teams beyond the top 100 with scores (2500+elem, 3000+mid, 3100+high) – 11 am ET on Monday, February 16th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 11am and the top 100+ ranked teams per division with state qualifying scores of 2500+elem, 3000+mid, and 3100+high will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight

selections can do so starting at 11am ET when registration opens for this tier of teams.)

- Tier 7: Qualifying second teams – 1pm ET on Monday, February 16th (second teams that received a qualifying score from the same state qualifier as their first team)
 - Auto flight selection will run before 1pm and any second teams that made a state qualifying score at the same state qualifier as their first team will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 1pm ET when registration opens up for this tier of teams.
- Tier 8: Qualifying individuals with scores (265+ elem, 275+ middle, 285+ high) and not with an advancing school team – 3 pm ET on Monday, February 16th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 3pm and any state qualifying individual whose school team did not advance will be notified by email of their selected flights. Individuals that need to make changes to their selected flight positions or to select flight positions due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 3pm ET when registration opens up for this tier.
- Registration will stay open for all schools to make changes and drops until the drop by date of Tuesday, February 17th at 8 am ET. Schools will be responsible for payment of all flight positions after the drop by date of Tuesday, February 17th at 8 am ET. (Positions may not be added at the state tournament. Only substitutions/swaps can be made on-site at the state tournament.)
- only individuals with state qualifying scores may pre-register/register. Coaches registering extra individuals without qualifying scores will cause all individuals from that school to be removed from the state tournament registration.
- Tuesday, February 17th, 2026 (8 AM ET) DROP BY DATE/TIME...deadline to drop flight positions. (You are responsible for paying for all flight positions you registered at this time.)

3D:

- KyNASP 3Dstate registration will use a new Auto Flight Selection/Registration process on Tuesday, February 17th, 2026. Drop by date is Thursday, February 19th at 8am ET.
- Only schools that select flight preferences during pre-registration will receive flight selections during the auto-flight selection if their flight preferences are available.
- It is critical that a school selects ALL flight times that they are willing to accept during pre-registration.
- Coaches will be notified of their 3D auto flight selection by email and then registration will open for them by the schedule below. This will allow them to make changes immediately instead of waiting for all flight selections to be made.
- **KyNASP State 3D Tournament auto-flight selection and registration schedule.** All pre-registered teams will be involved in an auto-flight selection process directly followed by a registration opening for changes. The auto flight selection process for each tier (group of ranked teams/individuals), will occur in two-hour increments. Once registration opens for a tier, changes

can be made. The tier will stay open for changes until the end of registration. **Rankings can be found at <https://www.nasptournaments.org> under the “Rankings” tab. Select “State Qualifying” tournaments and then select the state of KY.**

- Tier 1: Teams that ranked in the top 10 in their division – 9am ET on Tues, February 17th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 9am and the top 10 ranked teams per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 9am ET when registration opens for this tier of teams.
- Tier 2: Teams that ranked in the top 30 in their division – 11am ET on Tues, February 17th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 11am and the top 11 to 30 ranked teams per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 11am ET when registration opens for this tier of teams.
- Tier 3: Teams that ranked in the top 50 in their division – 1 pm ET on Tues, February 17th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 1 pm and the top 31 to 50 ranked teams per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 1 pm ET when registration opens for this tier of teams.
- Tier 4: Teams ranked beyond in the top 50 with scores (1225+elem, 1425+mid, 1475+high) – 3 pm ET on Tuesday, February 17th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 3 pm and the top 51+ with qualifying scores ranked per division will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 3 pm ET when registration opens for this tier of teams.
- Tier 5: Qualifying second teams – 5 pm ET on Tuesday, February 17th (second teams that received a qualifying score from the same state qualifier as their first team)
 - Auto flight selection will run before 5 pm and any second teams that made a state qualifying score at the same state qualifier as their first team will be notified by email of their selected flights. Teams that need to make changes to their selected flights or to select flights due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 5 pm ET when registration opens for this tier of teams.
- Tier 6: Qualifying individuals with scores (265+ elem, 275+ middle, 285+ high) and not with an advancing school team – 7 pm ET on Tuesday, February 17th
 - Auto flight selection will run before 7 pm and any state qualifying individual whose school team did not advance will be notified by email of their selected flights. Individuals that need to make changes to their selected flight positions or to select flight positions due to failure to secure auto flight selections can do so starting at 7 pm ET when registration opens for this tier.
- Registration will stay open for all schools to make changes and drops until the drop by date of Thursday, February 19th at 8 am ET. Schools will be responsible for payment of all flight positions

after the drop by date of Thursday, February 19th at 8 am ET. (Positions may not be added at the state tournament. Only substitutions/swaps can be made on-site at the state tournament.)

- only individuals with state qualifying scores may pre-register/register. Coaches registering extra individuals without qualifying scores will cause all individuals from that school to be removed from the state tournament registration.
- Thursday, February 19th, 2026 (8 AM ET) DROP BY DATE/TIME...deadline to drop flight positions. (You are responsible for paying for all flight positions you registered at this time.)

****Inclement weather policy: If a school district closes and all travel canceled due to inclement weather, registration fees will be waived in the event the entire team is unable to attend. The school Principal can email lisa.johnson@ky.gov with a message of "Our school will not be attending the KyNASP State Tournaments due to inclement weather." In the situation of inclement weather, the team's best state qualifying score can be used to post to the state virtual inclement weather tournament after the state tournament, as a chance to register for the National Tournament (tournament fees will be collected).

TOURNAMENT DETAILS

1. Parking: \$15 per entry for cars and \$30 for buses
2. For parking information and advanced purchasing of passes visit:

3. Admission – spectator admission will continue to be free for the KyNASP state tournaments this year.
4. Registration fee per tournament: \$35/archer (3 coaches free/team... 1 coach free/individual group) Bullseye registration fee is \$35/archer and 3D is an additional \$35/archer.
5. Tournament Hotels: a school can call Expo area hotels and ask for a National Archery in the Schools Program event rate.
6. Teams and individuals are required to provide their own arrows at State and National level events.
7. Coaches are required to have signed waivers on their person for all participants. Waivers can be downloaded from the fw.ky.gov/nasp page or the National NASP® tournaments page.

***Coaches must have valid BAI number, username & password for on-line registration access.

*** Once registration closes, you are responsible for submitting payment on the day of the tournament for all archers you have registered. Checks for the bullseye and 3D tournaments must be made payable to KY NASP® and may be combined as one check.

**** Changes after registration closes must be addressed on-site one hour or more before your flight time. Coaches may substitute registered archers but may not add archers.
