\_\_\_\_\_Volunteer Conservation Interpreter

This is a challenging position where volunteers interact with the general public by exhibit talks and table top activities. Good interpersonal skills are very helpful. Conservation Interpreters must attend all training sessions to gain knowledge about Kentucky's native fish and wildlife featured at Salato. Additional training is provided for those who have mastered the basic training sessions and wish to develop interpretive programs for the general public. **A minimum commitment of 16 hours a month is strongly encouraged. Interpreters must attend the required training sessions.**
