2024 KY NASP® State Championship



The 2024 KY NASP® State Championship will once again be held at the KY Exposition Center, located at 937 Phillips Lane, in Louisville. This year's event will be a three-day event, beginning on Thursday, March 28th and finishing on Saturday, March 30th. The competition will host over 8,000 very excited archers!

Advancing to State

All teams and individuals wishing for a chance to advance to the KyNASP® State Bullseye Championship must compete in at least one state qualifying tournament between December 1st, 2023 and March 2nd, 2024. Teams and individuals will be ranked during this time based on their best state qualifying score.

The top 100 elementary, top 120 middle, and top 140 high school teams will advance to the KyNASP® State Tournament.

Schools may only register one team per division. Second teams will have an opportunity to post scores in a virtual tournament after the state tournament for a chance to advance to the National Tournament if they can post a state qualifier score of 2500+ elementary, 3000+ middle, or 3100+ high.

The top 150 individuals by gender and division, not advancing as part of a team, will advance to the state tournament based on their highest state qualifying tournament score. If the

school team does not advance, view the top 150 individuals by gender and division listed in the rankings. If you have an archer on those lists, you may register them as an individual. Archers in the top 150 may be part of a team – this does not change the list of the top 150. (Rankings can be found at www.nasptournaments.org by clicking on the red "Rankings" button.

Teams and archers wishing to compete in the state 3D Challenge will be able to register under a tier system, based on scores obtained in a 3D Challenge State Qualifier. If space permits, the last tier allows teams or individuals to register if they qualified for the state bullseye tournament. Bullseye Flight Selection

Pre-Registration for the tournament began on January 1st. Auto assign will be used to determine flight times. Each team must select 5 or more flight time preferences at the time of pre-registration (select ALL preferences that you would accept, in the order you prefer). Failure to choose enough preferences may cause the auto assign feature to not assign a flight time at all.

Pre-Registration for the tournament will close at 8am ET on Sunday, March 3rd and registration auto assign will run by 5pm ET. At this time, coaches may view assigned flight times and prepare to make adjustments/changes if needed.

Registration will open for coaches to make changes to their roster or flight times by ranking on the following schedule:

Teams that ranked in the top 10 in their division – 8am ET on Monday, March 4th

Teams that ranked in the top 25 in their division – 9am ET on Monday, March 4th

Teams that ranked in the top 50 in their division – 10am ET on Monday, March 4th

Teams that ranked in the top 75 in their division – 11 am ET on Monday, Monday 4th

Teams that ranked in the top 100 in their division – noon ET on Monday, March 4th

Teams that ranked in the top 140 in their division – 1pm ET on Monday, March 4th

Individuals ranked in the top 150 not participating on a team – 2pm ET on Monday, March 4th

3D Challenge Flight Selection

3D Challenge Registration Tiers - Tuesday, March 5

- Tier 1: Teams ranked 1 10 from state qualifying scores 10am ET
- Tier 2: Teams ranked 11 22 from state qualifying scores 12pm (noon) ET
- Tier 3: Teams ranked 21-50 from SQ scores & individuals that will not be on a 3D team that shot in a 3D SQ 2pm ET
- Tier 4: Any team or individual that qualified for the state bullseye tournament 3 pm ET

Archer Registration Fees

Archer Bullseye Registration Fee: \$35 per registered archer will apply for this event. Archers will NOT receive a state t-shirt this year. A school must pay the registration fee for ALL archers registered at the close of registration (at 8am ET on 3/7) regardless of participation. Bring checks/payments **made payable to KY NASP®** and present to the registration desk before participation. Place the school name and "Kentucky" in the memo line on all checks.

Archer 3D Challenge Registration Fee: \$25 per registered archer will apply for this event. Archers will NOT receive a state t-shirt this year. A school must pay the registration fee for ALL archers registered at the close of registration, regardless of participation. Please bring checks/payments **made payable to IBO** and present to the registration desk before participation. Place the school name and "Kentucky" in the memo line on all checks.

The targets used at the Kentucky NASP® State Tournament will be on sale after the tournament. The targets are the standard Morrell Youth Target that has been "beefed up" for the state tournament. They are not recommended for use by a school that is practicing with them daily. They are recommended more for home use or for use at a school-hosted tournament. The targets are able to be re-stuffed as needed.

Reservations begin on March 1st (early reservations will not be accepted). It will be first come, first served. Email christie.kynasp@gmail.com and provide the name of the person paying or picking up the target, the number of targets requested, and a cell phone number. Payment (cash or check made payable to KY NASP®) is due at the tournament by 1:00 pm on Saturday and can be made at the south podium. Pickup is immediately following the last flight on Saturday (approximately 5:00 pm). If you are picking up multiple targets, the bay door in the back corner of North Hall will open as soon as the venue clears out enough for vehicles to be driven inside the facility.

State Tournament Scholarships \$35,000

We've almost doubled the amount of scholarships given at the state tournament! How does a total of \$35,000 sound?!

The top 15 scoring senior males and top 15 scoring senior females at the 2024 KyNASP® State Bullseye Tournament will each receive a \$1000 scholarship to the post-secondary institution they will be attending after graduation.

In addition to the senior scholarships, 10 random senior Academic Archer drawings will be held throughout the state tournament for \$500 scholarships.


