November 15, 2024 Kentucky Waterfowl Ground Counts

This is the ground count survey for November 11 - November 15, 2024. The region experienced varied, mild weather throughout the week, with rainfall of up to 2 inches in some areas due to showers and thunderstorms early in the week. Western Kentucky remains in a state of moderate drought. Although recent rainfall helped improve conditions slightly, long-term deficits persist from dry summer months. The Ohio and Mississippi Rivers' levels have generally remained stable but are slightly below normal.

Avian Influenza is present in Kentucky, so hunters should use common sense when handling/cleaning harvested waterfowl. See page two of the Waterfowl Guide for recommendations for the safe handling and disposal of your birds. After cleaning waterfowl, hunters are encouraged to place the remains in trash bags and dispose of them through trash collection or a permitted landfill. Bald eagles and other raptors are particularly susceptible to avian influenza. This simple action could help prevent bald eagle and other raptor mortalities.
