January 13, 2022 Kentucky Waterfowl Ground Counts

This is the ground count survey for January 9-13, 2023. The frigid weather that swept through at Christmas has given way to a couple mild weeks. We do continue to receive some rain, and some rain events were heavy enough to swell the bigger rivers and cause some backwater and headwater flooding from the smaller tributaries. Ducks have spread out across the newly flooded habitats, making surveying difficult in some areas. The mid-winter aerial survey was flown last week, and will be posted online as soon as all the data can be compiled.

**Avian Influenza is present in Kentucky, so hunters should use common sense when handling/cleaning harvested waterfowl. See page two of the KY Waterfowl Guide for recommendations for the safe handling and disposal of your birds. After cleaning waterfowl, hunters are encouraged to place the remains in trash bags and dispose of them through trash collection or a permitted landfill. Bald eagles and other raptors are particularly susceptible to avian influenza. This simple action could help prevent bald eagle and other raptor mortalities.

The second segment of duck season will run until January 31, 2023. Goose season opened November 24, 2022, and will remain open until February 15, 2023. New this year, youth season is Saturday, November 19, 2022, and Saturday, February 11, 2023. There is also a new veteran's hunt on Sunday, November 20, 2022, and Sunday February 12, 2023.
