January 21, 2022 Kentucky Waterfowl Ground Counts

This is the ground count for January 17 through January 21, 2022. Another big cold front has swept through, leaving some frozen water in it's path. Most shallow water areas and areas protected from wind will likely freeze and stay locked up over the weekend. Expect ducks to congregate near open bodies of water. The Ohio River is receding, opening most roads back up at Sloughs and Ballard WMAs, however access to most Boatwright is still not possible for vehicles. Ballard WMA reopened on Wednesday, but backwater rules remain in effect for Boatwright WMA. Remember, extreme caution is advised when attempting to hunt in backwater situations.

Backwater rules are in effect for <u>Boatwright WMA</u> through at least Sunday, January 23. All hunters must check in and be assigned a spot through the in-person drawing. See waterfowl hunting <u>guide</u> for details.

Growing conditions this summer were favorable for both planted crops and moist soil plants. Most areas are still reporting ample food available for ducks. Water levels in hunt units are where we want them. Overall, wetland conditions and food availability remain excellent.

Duck season will run until January 31, 2022. Goose season will remain open until February 15, 2022. The western zone youth hunt will be February 5-6, 2022. All bag limits remain the same as last season. Check out the waterfowl hunting <u>web page</u> for more details.
