December 2, 2022 Kentucky Waterfowl Ground Counts

This is the ground count survey for November 28 – December 2, 2022. We continue to struggle with water in our hunt units. Rains last week did allow for pumps and wells to be ran for a time, however lack of rain since caused Ohio and Mississippi River levels to drop again. River levels have not reached a sustained elevation to increase water levels in some of our units. Ballard WMA does have enough water now to hunt all 14 parties when it opens on December 7. Boatwright WMA is offering fewer than normal hunting sites due to lack of water.

Avian Influenza is present in Kentucky, so hunters should use common sense when handling/cleaning harvested waterfowl. See page two of the <u>KY Waterfowl Guide</u> for recommendations for the safe handling and disposal of your birds. After cleaning waterfowl, hunters are encouraged to place the remains in trash bags and dispose of them through trash collection or a permitted landfill. Bald eagles and other raptors are particularly susceptible to avian influenza. This simple action could help prevent bald eagle and other raptor mortalities.

Duck season began on Thanksgiving Day, and ran from November 24 – 27. The second segment of duck season opens on December 7 and will run until January 31, 2023. Goose season opens November 24, 2022 and will remain open until February 15, 2023. New this year, youth season is Saturday, November 19, 2022, and Saturday, February 11, 2023. There is also a new veteran's hunt on Sunday, November 20, 2022, and Sunday February 12, 2023. All bag limits remain the same as last season.
