

**PEABODY WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA  
STARFIRE AND ROBINSON FOREST WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA**

**EVENT PERMIT APPLICATION**

*Applicability: Per KRS 301 KAR 4:100 and 4:200, an annual event permit or an individual event permit may be issued to a group to participate as a group during a scheduled activity or event to take place on Peabody Wildlife Management Area or Starfire and Robinson Forest Wildlife Management Areas. The annual event permit entitles the group to participate and use the Wildlife Management Areas during certain dates determined by the department (the department shall determine applicable dates taking into consideration management of the area, other event conflicts and proposed events to take place on the WMA). An individual event permit entitles a group to participate and use the WMAs during certain dates not to exceed four (4) days. Annual event permits shall be valid March 1 through the end of February of each year. A new annual event permit application shall be made each year. In addition to the event permit, a group will need to obtain a free Wildlife Management Area Use permit.*

\_\_\_\_\_ Access and participation in hunting, fishing and recreational activities shall occur in the designated areas as set forth on this permit.

\_\_\_\_\_ The designated activity areas may include lands that have been mined by surface and underground mining methods.

\_\_\_\_\_ The group agrees to become familiar with the designated lands before beginning access for hunting, fishing or recreation. If there is ever any doubt as to whether access is permitted in an area, the group shall stay out of the area until certain that it is permitted.

\_\_\_\_\_ The group understands that it does not have the power to transfer this permit to another person or group, family or organization.

\_\_\_\_\_ The group assumes all risk and responsibility for any personal injury (including death) or property damage that arises out of our exercise of rights to access on the designated areas.

\_\_\_\_\_ The group agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless either the Peabody Wildlife Management Area or the Starfire and Robinson Forest Wildlife Management Area, depending on which WMA the group was granted an event permit, against any claim of any person for damages for personal injury (including death) or property damages that result in whole or part from the group's exercise of rights to access on designated areas.
