Yes No Exterior fence completely encloses the foxhound training enclosure and is at least five (5) feet above ground level for the intire length. Exterior fence consists of woven wire, chain link, or a material of equivalent strength capable of preventing escape of red fox and coyote. Exterior fence has a minimum of 12 inches of fence bent inward at a 90-degree angle or one (1) strand of electric wire at the top of the fence at minimum. Red foxes and coyotes are kept in sanitary and safe conditions that prevent maltreatment or neglect.

Minimum Enclosure Sizes and Associated Requirements for Quarantine Pen (301

KAR 2:081) Fox

A fox shall be held in an enclosure with the following minimum specifications:

- 1. A single animal enclosure shall be 8 ft. x 8 ft. x 6 ft., and
- 2. There shall be thirty (30) square feet floor space for each additional animal.

Coyote

A **coyote** shall be held in an enclosure with the following minimum specifications:

- 1. A single animal enclosure shall be 8 ft. x 8 ft. x 6 ft.; and
- 2. There shall be twenty-five (25) square feet floor space for each additional animal.

Non-Commercial Formound Training Enclosure Requirements (301 KAR 2:041)

Minimum Enclosure Size = 40 Acres

Minimum Number of Dens = At least 1 den per 40 acres AND at least one den for each red fox and covote

Commercial Foxhound Training Enclosures Requirements (301 KAR 2:041)

Minimum Enclosure Size= 200 Acres

Minimum Number of Dens = At least 1 den per 40 acres AND at least one den for each red fox and coyote
