___I, the undersigned, shall indemnify and hold harmless KDFWR and all of its officers, agents, and employees from all suits, actions or claims of any character because of any injuries or damages received by any person, persons, or property resulting from my holding of wildlife species in captivity based upon this authorization, to the extent allowed by Kentucky law. No part of this agreement shall constitute, either directly or indirectly, a waiver of sovereign immunity granted under the Kentucky Constitution, Section 231, and the United States Constitution, Eleventh Amendment.

___I understand that receipt and cashing of payment does not imply approval of permit request. Correct payment must accompany application.

___ I certify and understand that my permit shall be revoked and/or denied and wildlife may be confiscated if I fail to comply with the provisions of this administrative regulation (301 KAR 2:041), 301 KAR 2:230, or 301 KAR 2:251, if I am convicted of a violation of KRS Chapter 150, any department regulation, or any federal statute or regulation related to hunting, fishing, or wildlife or if I falsify information on this application, reports, or corresponding documents.

___ I certify that I have not been convicted for a violation of KRS Chapter 150.

___ I certify and understand that it is my responsibility to renew and possess a valid foxhound training enclosure permit prior to the expiration date listed on the permit.

___I understand that I am responsible for following all federal and state laws, local ordinances, and rules regarding wildlife.

___I understand that I must possess a valid Foxhound Training Enclosure Permit **BEFORE** I possess or transport red fox or coyote.

___I understand that I must attain red fox and coyotes from a legal source, location, and season.

Minimum Enclosure Sizes and Associated Requirements for Quarantine Pen (301 KAR 2:081)

Fox

A **fox** shall be held in an enclosure with the following minimum specifications:

1. A single animal enclosure shall be 8 ft. x 8 ft. x 6 ft.; and
2. There shall be thirty (30) square feet floor space for each additional animal.

Coyote

A **coyote** shall be held in an enclosure with the following minimum specifications:

1. A single animal enclosure shall be 8 ft. x 8 ft. x 6 ft.; and
2. There shall be twenty-five (25) square feet floor space for each additional animal.

Non-Commercial Foxhound Training Enclosure Requirements (301 KAR 2:041)

Minimum Enclosure Size = 40 Acres

Minimum Number of Dens = At least 1 den per 40 acres AND at least one den for each red fox and coyote

Commercial Foxhound Training Enclosures Requirements (301 KAR 2:041)

Minimum Enclosure Size = 200 Acres

Minimum Number of Dens = At least 1 den per 40 acres AND at least one den for each red fox and coyote
