Minimum Enclosure Sizes and Associated Requirements for Quarantine Pen (301 KAR 2:081)

Fox

A fox shall be held in an enclosure with the following minimum specifications:

- 1. A single animal enclosure shall be 8 ft. x 8 ft. x 6 ft.; and
- 2. There shall be thirty (30) square feet floor space for each additional animal.

Coyote

A **covote** shall be held in an enclosure with the following minimum specifications:

- 1. A single animal enclosure shall be 8 ft. x 8 ft. x 6 ft.; and
- 2. There shall be twenty-five (25) square feet floor space for each additional animal.

Non-Commercial Foxhound Training Enclosure Requirements (301 KAR 2:041)

Minimum Enclosure Size = 40 Acres

Minimum Number of Dens = At least 1 den per 40 acres AND at least one den for each red fox and coyote

Commercial Foxhound Training Enclosures Requirements (301 KAR 2:041)

Minimum Enclosure Size= 200 Acres

Minimum Number of Dens = At least 1 den per 40 acres AND at least one den for each red fox and coyote
