



Directions & Description:

From London travel north on KY-30 21 miles. Right on KY-1431 in Tyner. Follow KY-1431 1.2 miles to state hwy 1709. Turn right on state highway 1709 and travel 5.0 miles to KY-577. Turn left on KY-577 and travel 0.6 mile to Buncomb Rd. Turn left on Buncomb Rd and travel 0.3 mile. Slight right on E Buncomb Rd / Old Island City Rd for 0.4 mile.
