## **RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES**

- Fishing, hunting, hiking, horseback riding, wildlife watching, mountain bike riding, archery range, disc golf, geocaching and picnicking.
- Carry-down launch ramp at Ohio River for canoes, kayaks and small boats.
- Groups holding events of 30 people or more must apply in advance for an event permit.
- Motorized off-roading is not allowed on the area.
- Campground for either primitive or RV camping; additional fees will apply.
- Pistol and rifle range.
- Check online at *fw.ky.gov* before your visit for current information.

## **FISHING**

- Area includes five miles of Otter Creek and frontage along the Ohio River.
- Trout will be stocked in Otter Creek three times in the spring and a fourth time in October.
  State permit required to keep trout.
- A catch-and-release season for trout runs from October through the end of March.
- Anglers must possess a valid entry permit and have an appropriate fishing license and permit, if applicable.

## HUNTING

- Spring squirrel hunting available under statewide season; see map for hunting locations.
- Hunters must possess a valid entry permit and have valid hunting licenses and permits, if applicable.
- Opportunities planned in fall for small game, furbearer, deer and turkey hunting.
- Quota firearm hunts planned for deer, in addition to separate archery and crossbow seasons.
